

Deb and Dave Gatto, Loretta and John Gill meet at the entrance to River Club at 4pm on Tuesday the 5th. We took a look at what could be done to improve the line of sight over the bushes that line the center island of the entrance. We suggest that all the shrubs be removed except the tall cluster of plants circled in the picture, and replace the removed shrubs with sod. See picture #1.

Eureka Palms by building 12 can be pruned back to a manageable height, by cutting down and removing tall branches. See picture #2

Tall Palm tree by building 12 should be removed and stump ground, it rubs on roof of building. See picture #3

Plants that were cut back by building 13 could be removed and replaced with sod or just a hard cut back twice a year in March and September. Either way would work. See picture #4

Plants that were cut back by building 2 have to have a hard cut back twice a year because trees are too close together to mow sod in between them. See picture #5

Behind buildings 9 and 10 by the wall we suggest that 707 does not trim or edge the sod and just let it grow to reach the mulch.

These were our observations and suggestions for you all to consider. Please feel free to add any thoughts you may have.
