Officer Reports:

John Mears, President, reported:

1) Building 1 / Shoreline Stabilization: A third opinion was submitted by Bill Mathers Engineering. The Board has approved the Sheeting for the embankment and will get with the contractors for the final bids. The attorney determined the embankment decision was a maintenance issue.

Drainage Issue: John Gill met with Roger Baber, John Mears, Kelly Schulz, Phil Bollman and Dave Gatto to review the proposed plans to resolve this issue. The Board approved funds for material and labor for the installation, the plans and supervision of the work by Roger Baber.

Notification will follow regarding the details of the projects to all unit owners.

2) QXC TV / Internet: The Board approved to buy out AT&T in order to complete the installation by November 1st for training to start in October or November. Once finalized, QXC will be contacting each owner to set up an appointment to coordinate installation and training; whether a full time resident or a snowbird no one will be missed. Nancy Keough, Vice President, thanked Cheryl Hanlon for recognizing and advising the Board of many needs that were not being met with our cleaning company. Her efforts were instrumental in revising the contract and addressing the concerns.

Thomas Edwards, Treasurer, reported \$931,000 in Cash & Other Assets with Reserves of \$812,000. Thank you to the residents for the \$44,500 paid in advance on the Common Charges.

Loretta Gill, Director at Large, asked John Gill to report for the Landscape Committee. A total of 239 plants & 317 bushes were planted; sod laid in place of mulch and dead bushes and suggestions to eliminate water spray on cars. Proposals have been made to install 2 doors in front of the Commercial Dumpster for aesthetics and a larger sail over the BBQ area by the maintenance building for adequate shade.

John Gill thanked Mark Jennings, Carl Peterson, and Jim Ballard, Jim Linker, Dan Cregan, Larry Hanlon and Chip Bellows for laying sod; Diane Ward for care of the patio planters and the regulars: Loretta Gill, Dave & Deb Gatto, and Judy Agan. John Mears also thanked the Committee.
