To the Residents of Building 13,

Recently, while trimming the Areca palms that are in the back of building 13 and adjacent to the River Club entrance it was discovered that the palms have contracted gonaderma. This is a fatal disease to palm trees because there is no treatment that can cure the palms of the disease other than cutting them down. The Areca palms cannot be replaced with healthier palms because the gonaderma spores remain in the ground and will contaminate them. Currently, the Landscape Committee is investigating a suitable replacement for the palms with the objective of planting the replacements in the Fall of 2021. We appreciate your patience as we resolve this issue.
